Dear Sirs,

On behalf of Horsham Society I wish to lodge an objection to Planning Application DC/18/0747, which relates to signage for the Piries Place development.

With exception of the canopy sign, we consider the signage to be acceptable. However, we do have concerns regarding the logo style that has been used, which we find somewhat uncomfortable and believe that this should be reviewed.

Regarding the proposed canopy into the Carfax, we are led to understand that this will incorporate a bronze finish, to match finishes proposed in Piries Place. However, fronting onto the Carfax, bronze does not feature in the street scene and consideration should be given to re-specifying the materials for the canopy. Furthermore, a roof is proposed for the canopy, although there is a gap between it and the adjacent buildings. A roof will also require some form of lighting to the

underside. We consider the roof to be an unnecessary feature, without which the canopy could be more attractive. If lighting is still required, up/down lighters could be featured on the flank walls.

It is for the above reasons that Horsham Society object to Planning Application DC/18/0747.
