I am writing on behalf of the Planning Sub Committee for Horsham Society, who have concerns regarding Planning Application DC/19/1639, and therefore object to the proposals for the following reasons:

- 1) The proposed site at 104 Bishopric is extremely small with minimal access, apart from a narrow footpath for pedestrians. Therefore there is no provision for vehicular parking.
- 2) The proposed siting and size of the dwelling will encroach on both the canopies and root spread of adjacent mature trees, thus endangering them.

It is for the above reasons that we object to this application.
